Obituary

On August 25, 1917 **MOLLIE ANN SMITH**, the fourth of nine children, was born to George and Frances McKee of Big Creek, Mississippi. At an early age she accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior.

Mother Smith completed her formal education in Pittsboro, Mississippi where she fell in love and later married one of her teachers, the late Rev. Jason T. Smith (March 4, 1933). Rev. and Mrs. Smith moved to Chicago, Illinois in 1938 where they later started their family. Of this union seven children (two boys and five daughters) were born. Jason, Jr. preceded them in death in 1968.

In Chicago, Mother Smith accepted membership in the Revival Center Church and remained faithful through the pastorates of her brother-in-law, the late Bishop J.D. Smith, her husband, the late Rev. Jason T. Smith and later her daughter Mildred L. Grant. Mother Smith's service to the Trustee and Mother's Boards will long be remembered. The Mollie Ann Smith Dining Hall has been dedicated in her memory and honor.

Faithful, loving, generous, kind, long-suffering, supportive and always smiling are just some of the many attributes that would describe Mother Mollie Smith. She carried out her duties to God and to her church joyfully until she became incapacitated by an extended illness and was confined to the Belhaven Nursing Home.

On Sunday, September 12, 1993 at 7:20 a.m. God called Mother Mollie Smith home from labor to reward.
